
To Issac Newman:

We would like to extend special thanks to the following members from the Citywide Mobile Response Service that were present at the above mentioned event:

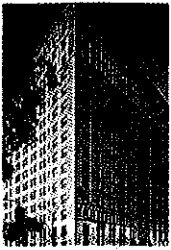
